Terms your subeditor may query

Nadcap	The aerospace industry's cooperative supplier accreditation programme for special processes and laboratories. Administered by PRI. Audits are conducted to a single global set of criteria; there is no national variant.
AC7101	The Nadcap audit criteria document for Materials Testing Laboratories. Numbered sub-parts cover mechanical testing (/3), metallography and microindentation hardness (/4), macro hardness (/5), specimen preparation (/7) and proficiency testing (/14).
Alpha case	A hard, brittle, oxygen-enriched layer that forms on the surface of titanium when it is worked or heat treated in an uncontrolled atmosphere. It can initiate cracking in service, so aerospace specifications require it to be detected and removed. Evaluated metallographically under AC7101/4 code L8.
Electrical conductivity inspection	A non-destructive eddy-current measurement used to confirm that an aluminium alloy has reached the intended temper after heat treatment. Accredited under AC7101/5 code M4.
Independent laboratory	A Nadcap designation recorded on the certificate. It means the laboratory does not perform the processes it verifies, so there is no conflict between the party doing the work and the party measuring it.
eAuditNet	PRI's online system carrying the Qualified Manufacturers List, the public record of who holds which Nadcap accreditation and to what scope.

Wording we ask you to avoid, and why

&ldquo;Nadcap certified&rdquo;;	The correct term is accredited. Nadcap accredits laboratories and processes; it does not certify companies.
&ldquo;Nadcap approved for heat treatment&rdquo;;	TCR holds AC7101 Materials Testing only. It has never held and does not claim AC7102 heat treatment.
&ldquo;TCR is the only Indian Nadcap laboratory&rdquo;;	Not our claim. The claim is that TCR is the first Indian group with two of its own laboratories separately accredited under AC7101.
&ldquo;NABL TC-6905&rdquo;;	Superseded on 3 March 2026. The current NABL certificate number is NABLT0726MH18640.
&ldquo;Transparency. Certainty. Reliability.&rdquo;;	The tagline is Transparency. Competence. Reliability.
